

ALABAMA PROSPECTIVE TEACHER TESTING PROGRAM (APTTP) PRAXIS II SUBJECT ASSESSMENTS REQUIRED FOR ALABAMA CERTIFICATION

The State Board of Education adopted minimum passing scores for the Praxis II assessments on February 9, 2006, effective immediately for individuals who apply for initial certification on or after April 14, 2006. New minimum passing score requirements were adopted by the State Board of Education on October 12, 2006; December 14, 2006; and March 8, 2007, effective immediately for individuals who apply for initial certification on or after June 1, 2007. Additionally, individuals who completed approved teacher education programs at Alabama colleges or universities prior to June 1, 2007, and whose applications were received on or after December 31, 2007, are required to attain the current minimum passing scores. The current score requirements are shown in the chart below. Individuals who submitted completed applications for certification prior to June 1, 2007, should contact the teacher testing staff at 334-242-9983 for score requirements in effect prior to June 1, 2007.

^a Effective September 12, 2008, Educational Testing Service is converting these assessments from an older scale score range of 250-990 to their more commonly used scale score range of 100-200, as follows:

- The Family and Consumer Sciences test code will change from 0120 to 0121. The converted score requirement for test code 0121 is 146.
- The Marketing Education test code will change from 0560 to 0561. The converted score requirement for test code 0561 is 135.
- The School Psychologist test code will change from 0400 to 0401. The converted score requirement for test code 0401 is 143.

Praxis II Subject Assessments Required for Alabama Certification Through Approaches Other than State-Approved Teacher Education Programs Or Through Reinstatement of Expired Certificates

Individuals applying for certification in the fields shown in the chart below through approaches other than completion of a state-approved program at an Alabama college or university must meet the requirements for the Praxis II subject assessment designated in the chart as a precondition for certification. These certification approaches include: reciprocal agreements or recognition, foreign credentials, and alternative approaches (including alternative baccalaureate-level certificates, special alternative Class A certificates, speech and language impaired approach, nationally certified school psychologist approach, National Board for Professional Teaching Standards Approach, and preliminary certificate approach). Additionally, individuals who have previously attained certification in one of these fields, and whose certificates have expired, must meet the prescribed Praxis II subject assessment requirements as a precondition for certification.

Note: Alternative certificate holders for grades 6-8 or 9-12 should take the test appropriate for the 6-12 grade span in the appropriate field for which the Professional Educator Certificate will be issued. Alternative certificate holders for grades K-8 should take the test appropriate for the P-12 grade span in the appropriate field for which the Professional Educator Certificate will be issued.
