- Earn 90 or above on the Pre-Algebra End-of-Course Exam.
*For students taking Algebra in the 8th grade, four (4) additional mathematics credits must be earned in grades 9 through 12.

*Grades earned prior to the 9th grade year will not be calculated into the high school Grade Point Average (GPA).
