Our Week:

In shared reading, we are enjoying books about colors! We are learning about concepts of print such as the difference between letters and words, understanding that spaces separate words, and learning what the author and illustrator do.

In math, we are continuing to count! We are also continuing to build our knowledge of numerals 0-10 by comparing amounts and determining more and less. We are practicing writing our numerals, playing games, and doing activities to help us match the numeral to its amount.

In science/social studies, we are creating "I Can" charts for each of our centers. We are discussing things we can do in each center to help us know the expectations for each area.

We are also continuing to build our community during morning meeting as we share our "All About Me" bags and read about how we can help one another by working together and filling one another's buckets with kind words and actions.
