What will we be learning?

<u>Math</u>: We have finished our graphing chapter and will be moving on to the concepts of MULTIPLICATION (YAY!!!) Students will investigate Real-World sets to help us understand multiplication.

Reading/English Language Arts: Grammar - We will learn how to distinguish the difference between COMMON and PROPER NOUNS. We will practice using COMMON and PROPER NOUNS in our writing. Writing - Students will work to finish their personal narrative.

Reading - We start EXPOSITYORY TEXT this week. Our story is A Mountain of History. Students will learn about text features, main idea and key details, and multiple meaning words. Vocabulary - We are review Unit 1 for our test on Thursday. Students will be completing a study guide in class and I will also send home a study guide for homework.
