What will we be learning?

<u>Math</u>: We will begin Topic 1 (Understanding Multiplication & Division of Whole Numbers) - Students will learn strategies for multiplying numbers. Strategies include division: separating equal groups, using a multiplication problem to solve for division, and using repeated subtraction.

**Topic 1 Practice pages will be sent home for your child to practice as needed while we are learning concepts from Topic 1. These will NOT need to be turned in.

Reading/English Language Arts: Grammar - We will be investigating how and when to use VERBS in our writing and use text examples to see how verbs are used. Reading - Students are learning to identify a passage as first-person point of view and how to use resources (i.e. dictionary) to locate the meaning of a word as it is used in a sentence. Unit 1 passages are about Animal Characteristics.

Vocabulary - Students are learning vocabulary words that they will see in our reading passages. We will use context clues to determine the meaning & use the definition to help us create synonyms and antonyms for each word.

<u>Science:</u> Students are learning about Animal Characteristics. We will continue to study:

- life cycles of organisms (other than humans)
- inherited traits organisms get from their parents (*Examples: dogs and their offspring have fur and four legs, pine trees and their offspring have needles*).
