

Color Wheel Scavenger Hunt for Art



Remember seeing this in our art room? It's the Color Wheel – just one of the Elements of Art! One of our favorite elements for sure! Let's go on a scavenger hunt for items around our home to make our own color wheel.



Start by looking for items that are the Primary Colors: Red, Yellow and Blue. Place each color in one pile/group and make the 3 piles/groups form a TRIANGLE.



The RED group should be at the top of the triangle, the BLUE group to your right and the YELLOW group to your left.

Now go look for the Secondary Colors: Orange, Green and Purple. As you collect your items, place them in piles too! However, these piles go in specific places!

Red + Yellow = Orange

Place your ORANGE group between the Red and Yellow groups.

Yellow + Blue = Green

Place your GREEN group between the Yellow and Blue groups.

Blue + Red = Purple

Place your Purple group between the Blue and Red groups.



Here is my complete basic color wheel. It was fun to hunt for things around my home.

I found I did not have many purple things in my house! If you would like to take a picture and share your color wheel please do! Send the image back to your homeroom teacher however you usually share things with them. I will check in with the homeroom teacher to take a look.
