Short a:

the vowel says its sound when the
syllable ends in a consonant (cat).

k or ck:

ck is used after one short vowel
(clock, pack, stuck).

k is used after a consonant, vowel
team, or long vowel (bank, soak,
desk).

Sample words: hat, am, man, sack,
back, fan, glad, cab, pack, flat

Sample sentences: Tad can go with
Jan. Sam can slam the bat.
