In science this week we will begin a unit on survival and what adaptations animals and plants have to help them to survive in certain environments.

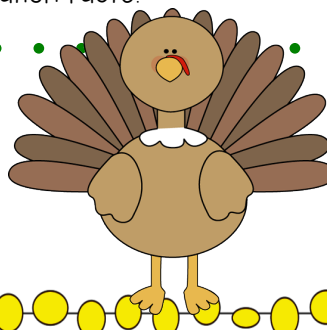
