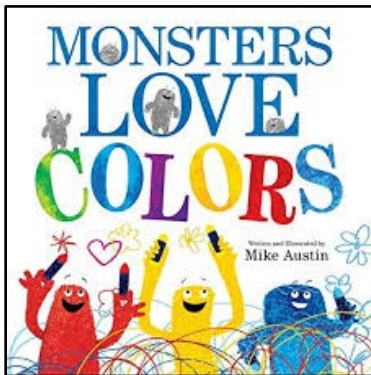

Supplies Needed

Black Crayon or Sharpie
White Paper
Circle for tracing
(masking tape or jar lid)
Crayons, Markers, or Paint

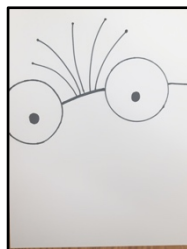
Step 1

Use your black crayon or sharpie to trace 2 circles for eyes; one circle should go off the edge of the page some.



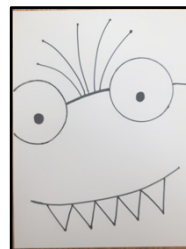
Step 2

Draw a curved line connecting the eyes and one that goes off the side of the page. Add some curved lines for hair!



Step 3

Draw a curved line for the mouth. Add triangle shaped teeth.



Step 4

Use crayons, markers, or paint to add color to your monster.



Extra Information

- Feel free to change your picture how you'd like-maybe you want 3 eyes instead of 2, a nose, crazy hair, or eyelashes!
- If you decide to paint with watercolor, try sprinkling salt on top of the wet paint for some added fun texture!
- Try mixing colors -OR- draw with crayon first and then paint over it!
