Please complete the online lunch form if you believe you may qualify for free or reduced lunch.



# **Registration & Residency**

If you have not yet completed your proof of residency and/or registration, please bring the required information to Ogletree <u>prior</u> to posting teacher placements. <u>Students who do not have completed information will not be placed in a class</u>. Please call Ogletree front office if you have questions. 887-4920

Acceptable Documents Include - Proof of residency: Current year property tax PLUS one current utility bill, or; Current SIGNED lease/rental agreement PLUS one current utility bill, or Current mortgage, mortgage statement, or Warranty Deed PLUS one current utility bill.

# **Arrival and Dismissal**

Please make sure to be prompt in your arrival to OES! <u>Every minute of instruction counts</u>! Students should be in their classroom, seated, ready to begin the day <u>no later than 7:30</u>. If riding in a car, please make sure students <u>do</u> not arrive earlier than 7:05. We DO NOT provide supervision prior to 7:05.

Bus schedules will be forthcoming as we receive information from our transportation department. Bus information will be available at Meet the Teacher, August 6th. You will need to notify your child's teacher how your child will go home at Meet the Teacher. There will be a quick form for you to complete.

- ◆ Arrival 7:05-7:30am 7:15am is preferable time to get a jump start on the day!
- Announcements and Dismissal of Bus, Walkers, Day Care Van Dismissal 2:20pm
- Car Rider Dismissal 2:25pm

Buses and day care vans will load and unload on the side of our drive closest to Ogletree Road. Car riders will use <u>car line closest to the soccer field and enter at the Ogletree sign</u>. Thank you for your patience in the first days of school as the line gets backed up. We have truly tried varying methods to expedite dismissal.

#### **Entering safely is our priority!**

#### **IMPORTANT! TRANSPORTATION CHANGES**

Transportation changes will not be accepted over email due to substitutes, teachers not checking email prior to dismissal, etc. Please send a written note with your child. NO BUS changes will be allowed without the transportation form required by our transportation department. The form can be found on OES web page under the parent tab.

## **Bus Reminders**

If your child rides the bus, remind him/her that the bus driver is in charge of getting students to and from school safely. Carefully review rules in the Parent Student Handbook found on ACS/OES web page. The handbook can also be found in the front of your child's planner.

#### **Consequences for not following bus rules:**

First Offense – One Week Loss of Bus Privileges
Second Offense – One Month Loss of Bus Privileges
Third Offense – Remainder of the Year Loss of Bus Privileges



## **Safety is Our Priority!**

- ⇒ Car Riders: Please make sure you enter and depart from the entrance by our Ogletree sign. You should never drop your child off in an area that is not designated for this purpose. People are not expecting that children will be dropped off in the parking lot, back of school, road or area where we do not have teachers on car duty. It is dangerous when some do not follow the traffic flow. Please leave your home early enough not to feel rushed and endanger anyone's safety.
- ⇒ <u>PLEASE DO NOT</u> use your cell phone when you are in the Ogletree Car Line! Use this time to talk with your child about his/her day, enjoy car time together, allow the excitement of something special to take place that only your child can share. Possible questions: What technology did you use today and how did you use it? When did you use the Golden Rule or see someone else be kind? What was your favorite part of your day and why? What is a book you are reading at school? What math are you doing this week?



## **Check-In Reminders**

We are working hard to protect your child. Any adult needing to check out or have access to a child at OES will need to present a valid government issued I.D./driver's license. This will be required every year if you plan to visit OES. The system will provide information that notifies police of anyone on the sex offender data base and make us aware not to allow access. Thank you for your support as we look for ways to support our families and keep our All Stars safe!

Please check in with our front office each time you visit. Make arrangements with teachers when you are visiting for lunch, wanting to volunteer and contribute in a positive way to our school. We look forward to being your partner!



## **OES Extracurricular Activities and Clubs**

We are fortunate to have many dedicated teachers and staff willing to sponsor and host a diverse offering of after school activities. Your child will be made aware during announcements to pick up the forms that interest them. It will be their responsibility to get forms, talk with you about their interest and return it to school. Remember, if your child doesn't pick up a form or talk with you about it, he/she probably doesn't want to participate. Children may only be able to participate in one/two clubs depending on availability. We have limited spaces for participation in some, so if your child is in multiple and we have a waiting list, you may have to choose which is priority to make sure those interested have slots.

#### **Guidelines to remember:**

- Students may be limited to the number of clubs they can join to open spaces for other participants.
- We ask that students be careful in their choices as not to overload their schedule, choosing only the opportunities that they are truly interested in participating to his/her fullest potential.
- Parents MUST pick their children up on time! Two late arrivals WILL RESULT in dismissal from the club/event.
   Teachers have appointments and plans after they have volunteered their time with your child(ren). Please do not take advantage of their generosity.
- Most clubs are designated for specific grade levels, have try-outs, not meet every week and/or may have prerequisite.
