Avoid the Summer Slide! Please encourage summer reading by signing your child up for the Summer Reading Program at the Auburn Public Library. Research shows that students who read over the summer and stay on top of their basic math facts have a 4 week advantage academically over their peers who do no academic maintenance over the 11 week summer break. Please work to keep your child engaged by reading to and with your child regularly. Make it a part of your summer routine instead of a dreaded chore or punishment. Use a deck of cards to play math games with your child to stay on top of math Fact Fluency.
