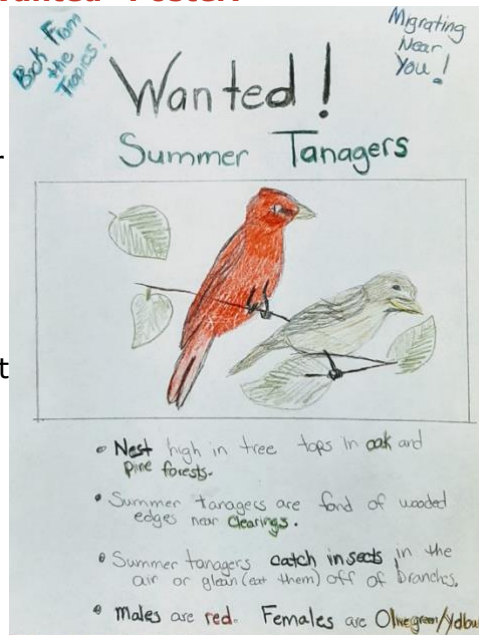

Follow the directions and you can even submit your artwork and what you have learned! Take care of yourselves, be safe and enjoy some nature!

This week's Challenge... Make a Migratory Bird "Wanted" Poster!

Step 1: Pick a migratory bird that either travels through Alabama or lives and nests in Alabama on its return from Central and South America!

Step 2: Read about it



on AllAboutBirds.org and/or in a field identification guide like the *National Audubon Field Guide to the Southeastern States*.

Step 3: Create a "Wanted" poster with its picture and include clues like where it nests, what it eats, how it behaves, and what sounds it makes.

Example Migratory Birds: barn swallow, great crested flycatcher, indigo bunting, parula warbler, purple martin, red-eyed vireo, ruby-throated hummingbird, scarlet tanager, or wood thrush
