## Scheduling an Appointment with Mr. Tindell

In an effort to provide you with first-class service during your college counseling session, please complete the 1 - 2 - 3 appointment process outlined below:

(1) Complete the **College Pre-Counseling Form** (available on the website at <u>www.auburnschools.org/Domain/165</u>); download, complete and save to your computer\*).

(2) On the website, click on "Scheduling and Events Calendar" –this will help with scheduling your appointment as it shows when I'm available v/s already scheduled (e.g., if the calendar indicates "Individual College Counseling" on a specific date/time, this is a privately-scheduled appointment, not an open invitation). **Please note:** *Scheduled appointments for individual college counseling may not commence prior to* <u>Monday, August 17, 2020</u>. (This is done in an effort to provide **all** seniors with equal opportunity and access to college counseling.)

(3) On the website, click on the email account: <u>jetindell@auburnschools.org</u>. You will be taken to a populated email addressed to me (Mr. Tindell). Simply complete the email, providing your name (and a student's name if you are a parent scheduling for your child) and telling me which dates/times would work best for you (please supply me with ~3 combos). Prior to sending the email, **make sure that you attach the** *completed* **pre-counseling form**.

I will schedule and confirm your appointment with me via return email.

\*If for some reason this isn't a feasible option, students, you may print, complete, and drop off the form to me in Office #1210. Likewise, if you do not have access to a computer, you may use the College Pre-Counseling Form contained within the College Counseling Manual—simply rip it out! ③
