Skill Focus ch and -tch

CH or TCH

How do you spell the sound /ch/ at the end of a word?

USE **TCH** WHEN

The word has **one syllable** AND it has one **short vowel** before the /ch/ sound



hatch



stretch



witch



crutch

USE **CH** WHEN

The word has **anything except just a short vowel** right before the /ch/ sound.



peach



inch



couch



lunch
