8TH GRADE COURSE OPTIONS

All students choose the following:

- Language Arts (Meets daily all year.)
- Math (Meets daily all year.)
 - 8th Grade Math
 - 8th Grade Accelerated Math
- Social Studies (Meets daily for one semester.)
- Science (Meets daily for one semester.)
- Fitness For Life (PE) (Meets alternating days (blue or white) all year.)

MATH AT AJHS

- 8th Grade Math For students in regular 7th
 Grade Math OR 7th grade accelerated math at ESS.
- 8th Grade Accelerated Math For students in 7th Grade Accelerated Math at ESS.

MATH AT AJHS

- No test will be given this year to jump students from Grade Level 7th grade math to Accelerated 8th Grade math.
 - ALL students who took grade level 7th grade math will be taking grade level 8th grade math.
- Students who took Accelerated 7th grade math may choose to take grade level 8th grade math.
- Students who take Accelerated 7th grade AND Accelerated 8th grade math will be given the chance to skip Algebra I in the 10th grade.
- All students will take Geometry in 9th grade. There will be a few different options on how the course will be presented, but all students will be taking this course.
 - Students in Accelerated 8th Grade math will be given a placement test to determine if they will be able to take Geometry/Algebra II w/ Trig in 9th grade.

8TH GRADE ELECTIVE OPTIONS

All electives alternate with PE for the entire year.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS CLASS OF 2026

- Students must earn 26 credits to graduate. It is possible for a graduating senior to earn up to 32 credits.
 - 4 Credits of English
 - 4 Credits of Math
 - These credits will begin in 9th grade with Geometry.
 - 4 Credits of Science
 - 4 Credits of Social Studies
- 1 credit of Beginning Kinesiology (1 JROTC may be substituted)
- $\frac{1}{2}$ credit of Health
- 1 credit of Career Preparedness
- $7\frac{1}{2}$ credits of electives

ADVANCED COURSES

Advanced Courses - .5 extra grade point awarded (A = 4.5)

- 9th Grade Advanced English
- 9th Grade Advanced Biology
- 9th Grade Advanced World History

AP/IB Courses = I extra grade point awarded (A = 5.0)
