- **Biology and World History swap in December and meet daily during the semester.**
  - **Advanced Courses for English, World History and Biology – ½ quality point on GPA.**

# Unacceptable Conduct

- **Using the network for illegal activities.**

- **Using personal hotspots to bypass the network.**
- **Accessing or exploring online locations or materials that do not support the curriculum or are inappropriate or illegal.**
