Acceptable Use


- Students are expected to use the iPad and other technology hardware, software, and computer networks including the internet as defined by the Student/Parent iPad Agreement.

Unacceptable Conduct

- Using personal hotspots to bypass the network.
- Accessing or exploring online locations or materials that do not support the curriculum or are inappropriate or illegal.
