IB History 12 Summer Work:

- 1. Summer work for Ms. Wheeler is to complete a full draft of your Internal Assessment. It will be due printed out on the FIRST DAY OF CLASS.
- 2. Use your research journals and your final presentation as a guide. Your draft should include the following:
 - Title Page:
 - Include Research Question, Your Name, Date, Candidate #, and Total Word Count (Under 2200). This should be formatted the same way we usually format title pages- same font as the rest of the paper with no extra embellishments.
 - Criterion A: Identification and Evaluation of Sources-500 Words
 - This section just needs to be updated from your draft back in January. Make any writing adjustments to eliminate unnecessary words. You may completely re-do if needed. **Emphasis on relevance, values, and limitations to your Research Question specifically.**
 - Criterion B: Historical Investigation- 1300 Words
 - This section is the actual investigation. You need to "answer" your question in this section. Be sure to mimic what you did on your final and in your research journals; be constantly evaluating and comparing historical perspectives throughout the paper.
 - By the end of the paper, you should come to a conclusion and justify it by bringing together the perspectives you analyzed.
 - You may divide this section into smaller sections (for example: Historical Context, By Perspective, etc.). It is not required that you do this.
 - Do not write in first person. YOU MUST INCLUDE FOOTNOTES with specific page numbers. Refer back to your research records.
 - Criterion C: Reflection on the Historical Process- 400 Words
 - You need to discuss multiple methods/challenges of this historian. Remember, you are not just discussing your research experience. You are discussing what you learned about history generally and using examples from your research to illustrate those takeaways. You may write in first person here.
 - **Bibliography:** At least 10 academic sources
- 3. Your draft should be what you consider to be a final paper you would turn in for a grade. This is the **only draft** you get with Ms. Wheeler, so turning in an uncompleted draft will lead to a lower quality final product.
- 4. Format should be how we always do it with a title page, pg. #'s, TNR 12 pt. font, etc. Make sure your citations are correct. Footnotes require *page numbers*. You do not need to include a word count for each section, just the total word count on the front.
- 5. ChatGPT or other Artificial Intelligence tools **are not allowed**. Ms. Wheeler has multiple AI checkers that she will use in addition to PlagScan for more standard plagiarism. Any use of these tools will result in a "zero" on the assignment and could result in further disciplinary action, including removal from the IB program or a failure to earn your hood/IB Diploma.
- 6. Summer communication:
 - Both Ms. Wheeler and Ms. Vatella check email about once per week. Please keep this in mind if you need assistance on any part of your paper.
- *You may not change your question without discussing with Ms. Wheeler or Ms. Vatella. Small adjustments are okay, but you may not make any significant changes.
