Welcome to Senior Year!

After you complete the College Counseling Orientation Seminar, you'll be able to schedule an individual appointment with me (should you desire to do so) to discuss "all things college" specific to you and your situation... During the orientation session, I'll provide you with a college readiness booklet containing information regarding admissions, important dates, college entrance exams, sample resumes, sample admissions and scholarship essays, and website information for both our school site as well as for *Kuder* and *Naviance*--lots of important senior stuff! I'll also provide you with online tutorials of both *Kuder* and *Naviance* and the "College Capstone," the website I created for seniors with regard to scheduling individual appointments with me, college admissions and scholarship-related information, as well as links to both scholarship search engines and financial aid resources and to college entrance testing services and admission portals—EVERYTHING college-related is provided on our in-house website ("The College Capstone")!

You (and your parents) are invited to attend *any* one of the orientation sessions presented during the week of <u>July 17-21</u>! In an effort to make sure that all seniors are provided equal access and opportunity to College Counseling, however, individual appointments may <u>not</u> begin until on (or after) August 14<sup>th</sup>. For all seniors, regardless of the college-of-choice, the *earliest* deadline for both admissions and scholarship acquisition will not occur until *at least* October 1<sup>st</sup> or 15<sup>th</sup> (and these deadlines are employed mostly by the Ivy-League and/or exclusively private schools); likewise, other schools' *earliest* important deadlines typically fall on November 1<sup>st</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup>, respectively. However, most colleges and universities use <u>December 1<sup>st</sup></u> as their *general* priority deadline! (But we'll discuss the nuts & bolts of dates and deadlines during the orientation session.)
