

How do I get a library card?

You may sign up for a library card by visiting auburnalabama.org/library, or in person at any service desk in the library. Applicants should have a photo ID and proof of residency.

The Auburn Public Library extends free borrowing privileges to anyone who:

- lives, owns, or rents property in Auburn, or
- is employed in Auburn, or
- attends a SACS-accredited educational institution, kindergarten through college, in Auburn, or
- has a valid Horseshoe Bend Regional Library card.

- Monday Thursday from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
- Friday & Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
- Sunday from 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

To place an item on hold for curbside pickup, visit our online catalog, or call our public services division at (334) 501-3195. Once you receive the notification that your holds are available for pickup, proceed to the library within 5 days to retrieve your items.

When you arrive

- Pull into the circular drive in front of the main entrance.
- Text "Here" to (334) 500-4075 to let us know you have arrived.
- Please have your library card number available for checkout.

If you are unable to text, you may call (334) 501-3195 to notify us of your arrival.

How do I log in?



- Install the CL app, or navigate to the library site in your browser. 1
- Select United States, Alabama, and Auburn Public Library from 2 the country, state, and library menus.
- Accept the terms and conditions. 3
- 4 Enter your "Library Card ID" (full library card number, located on the back of your card, without dashes or spaces).
- Enter your "PIN/Password." This is defaulted to the last 4 5 digits of the telephone number on your library account unless you created a custom password at sign up.

How do I log in to the app?



- 1 Install the Flipster app.
- 2 Click "Find A Library."
- 3 Click the "Log In" button next to Auburn Public Library.
- 4 Enter your library card number (full number located on the back of your card, without dashes or spaces). Please note, if you are connected to AuburnWeb Wi-Fi you will automatically be logged in without requiring a library card.
- 5 Click "Sign In."
