What a great start to the school year!

Thank you for your patience during arrival and dismissal. Please do not fret; it will get better. We are very meticulous with the arrival and dismissal process at the beginning of each school year because we want to ensure that all students are going to the correct places.

On tomorrow, Wednesday, August 12th, we will open our back bus loop to car riders that are traveling from Shug Jordan <u>only</u> from 7:30-7:50. Drop-off in the back loop will begin <u>after</u> the buses and daycare vans have dropped off.

In addition, note the following for safety purposes:

- 1. Parking at the tennis center, on Richland Road between us and the tennis center, and at the AU Club is strictly prohibited. There is a detailed video on our car line procedures located on our website.
- 2. Please have your child prepared to get out of the car when we open the doors, it will help the carline move a lot faster. Further, do not worry about being late, we will not issue tardies until everyone gets the carline routine down, which should be soon!
- 3. Hangtags will be issued to all students this afternoon. We will not allow any driver in the carline to pick up a student in the afternoons if they do not have a hangtag. Drivers will be asked to park and show ID in the main office and the student will be released <u>after</u> the carline is complete.
- 4. If your child is a walker, you should have your hangtag to pick them up as well, if not, you will be asked to walk to the main office and show your ID. Then your child will not be released until dismissal is complete. Parking on campus, or at the tennis center, is strictly prohibited if your child is a walker.
