Frequently Asked Questions

How does drop off and dismissal work?

Children are encouraged to be dropped off in the car line or ride the bus from your neighborhood. There will be teachers around the building to help them find their classrooms. If you prefer to, you are welcome to walk your child to the front doors of the school on the first day. The doors open at 7:15 and the tardy bell rings at 7:45. School ends at 2:35. If your child is a car rider, they will be given a car tag which you will need to pick them up in car line. Your tag will be scanned by a RES faculty member and your child will be waiting for you at the appropriate cone. Bus and Daycare riders will be dismissed from the back bus loop. Walkers will be dismissed from the end of B-Wing.
