2018-2019 ACS After School Program Registration

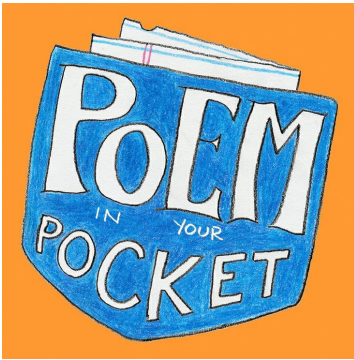
- Students, who are currently attending the After School Program, may register April 2- April 9.
