## **Registration & Residency**

If you have not yet completed your proof of residency and/or registration, please bring the required information to AEEC <u>prior</u> to August 1st. <u>Students who do not have completed information will not be placed</u> in a class. Please call our main office if you have any questions at (334)887-4950.

Acceptable Documents Include - Proof of residency: Current year property tax PLUS one current utility bill, or; Current SIGNED lease/rental agreement PLUS one current utility bill, or Current mortgage, mortgage statement, or Warranty Deed PLUS one current utility bill.



## **Arrival and Dismissal**

Please make sure to be prompt in your arrival to AEEC. <u>Every minute of instruction counts!</u> Students should be in their classroom, seated, ready to begin the day <u>no later than 7:45am</u>. If riding in a car, please make sure students <u>do not arrive earlier than 7:15</u>. We DO NOT provide supervision prior to 7:15. After 7:45am, please do not let your child out in the car rider line. Please drive and park in the front visitor parking lot to sign your child in with Mrs. Mary.

Bus schedules will be forthcoming as we receive information from our transportation department. Bus information will be available at Meet the Teacher, August 6th. You will need to notify your child's teacher how your child will go home at Meet the Teacher. There will be a quick form for you to complete.

- ◆ Arrival 7:15-7:45am 7:15am is the preferable time to get a jump start on the day!
- ◆ Dismissal of Bus and Day Care Van Students 2:35pm
- ◆ Car Rider Dismissal 2:35pm

Buses will load and unload in the front circle of AEEC. Car riders will use the back entrance to AEEC from Wrights Mill Road. Thank you for your patience in the first days of school as the line gets backed up. #### **IMPORTANT! TRANSPORTATION CHANGES**



## Bus Reminders

If your child rides the bus, remind him/her that the bus driver is in charge of getting students to and from school safely. Carefully review rules in the Parent Student Handbook found on ACS/AEEC web page.

#### **Consequences for not following bus rules:**

First Offense – Three Day Loss of Bus Privileges
Second Offense – One Week Loss of Bus Privileges
Third Offense – One Month Loss of Bus Privileges
4th Offense—Remainder of the Year Loss of Bus Privileges



# **Safety is Our Priority!**

- ⇒ Car Riders: Please make sure you enter and depart from the back entrance of AEEC. You should never drop your child off in an area that is not designated for this purpose. People are not expecting that children will be dropped off in the front visitor parking lot, back parking lot, road, or area where we do not have teachers on car duty. Please do not drop your child off in the front circle parking lot as it is a safety hazard.
- ⇒ PLEASE DO NOT use your cell phone when you are in the AEEC Car Line! Use this time to talk with your child about his/her day, enjoy car time together. Allow the excitement of something special to take place that only your child can share. Possible questions: What technology did you use today and how did you use it? When did you use the Golden Rule or see someone else be kind? What was your favorite part of your day and why? What is a book you are reading at school? What math are you doing this week?



## **Check-In Reminders**

We are working hard to protect your child. Any adult needing to check out or have access to a child at AEEC will need to present a valid government issued I.D./driver's license. This will be required every year if you plan to visit AEEC. The system will provide information that notifies police of anyone on the sex offender data base and make us aware not to allow access. Thank you for your support as we look for ways to support our families and keep our AEEC Cubs safe!

Please check in with our front office each time you visit. Make arrangements with teachers when you are visiting for lunch or wanting to volunteer. We look forward to being your partner!
