ASTHMA/ALLERGY SEASON

The season is beginning to change! If your child has Asthma or Allergies and may require *any medication at school,* please make sure to make an appointment with Nurse Tamika Foreman to obtain information on the paperwork that will need to be completed. Our main goal is to keep children healthy and in school so that they may learn.

SICK CHILD POLICY

With the stomach bug going around the tree, I wanted to send out a friendly reminder about our ACS policy on students that may become ill. In order to ensure the health and safety of all students, school nurses monitor the presence of symptoms indicating the potential presence of a communicable, or infectious, health condition. When indicative symptoms exist, your child must be excluded from school. *Please see the ACS Parent and Student Handbook for more information found on page 50.*

- **Persistent Fever**: Oral temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher. Your child must not attend school until fever free 24-hours without fever-reducing medication.
- **Vomiting**: Your child must not attend school if the following exist: One episode of vomiting + the presence of another symptom (fever, diarrhea, etc.); or Two or more episodes of vomiting within a 24-hour period, even if no other symptoms exist.
- **Diarrhea:** Your child must not attend school if the following exist: One episode of diarrhea + the presence of another symptom (dehydration, fever, etc.); or Three or more episodes of diarrhea in a 24-hour period, even if no other symptoms exist.
