Learning Focus

Reading –

We will finish with our class read aloud this week. Students will take a comprehension to assess their comprehension of the chapter book.

Writing–

For the next three weeks, students will be doing an in-depth studying on text dependent analysis for preparation of our ACAP testing. Students will also work on revising and editing of written work.

Social Studies –

Students will learn about the next steps after the American colonists' defeat of the British.

Math

Topic 14 focuses on developing understanding of the coordinate system and how to use ordered pairs to locate points in a plane.

Topic 15 focuses on patterns and relationships in number sequences, tables, and graphs.
